

## Member Benefits

- **Unlimited visits to a primary care doctor in our network.**
- **Care Grants** – Up to \$150 per child per year for services and supplies for social or physical activities, such as gym memberships, swim lessons, sports equipment, art supplies or application fees for post high school education.
- **\$25 Over-The-Counter Benefit** - \$25 provided per household per month to buy products like cough, cold and allergy medications, first aid supplies and vitamins.
- **Healthy Rewards Program** - Reward dollars are provided for taking steps to protect your child's health by completing certain preventive health activities, such as well child visits for some age groups and weight loss coaching.
- **Transition Assistance** - Up to \$500 in one-time assistance for young adults transitioning out of foster care at age 18 or extended foster care at age 21.
- **Life Skills Development** - Education for children ages 12 and up with developmental disabilities to help them keep, learn or improve skills and functioning for daily living.
- **Transportation** - Unlimited to medical appointments; 3 trips per month for non-medical needs.

Some of our members have never visited a pediatrician or received the care they need to keep them healthy. Our plan benefits support children on their road to recovery with needed and preventive medical and behavioral health services.

***Sunshine Health provides personalized healthcare for children in Florida's child welfare system to help them get and stay well – both physically and emotionally.***

Because we understand that improving health for children in the state's child welfare system is a community effort, we build a care coordination network around every child to best support his/her individual needs. Our integrated physical and behavioral health approach brings together healthcare providers, community-based care agencies, child welfare providers, and foster, adoptive and biological parents to create a care plan to match each child's needs.

Our specialized programs and services are offered at no cost to every child in or adopted from the state's child welfare system.

## Who Can Enroll?

Children who are eligible for the Child Welfare Specialty Plan include:

- All children with an open child welfare case, regardless of placement;
- Children in extended foster care through age 21; and
- All children who have been adopted through the child welfare system and who are receiving an adoption subsidy through age 18.
